



The Gold Awardee Scholarship

The Affiliate Council of The Engineering Society of Detroit is pleased to announce a scholarship will be awarded to a student studying in the career field designated by our Gold Award Recipient. The scholarship is sponsored by friends of the Gold Awardee and the Affiliate Council of the Engineering Society of Detroit.

Eligibility

Relatives of current Affiliate Council officers, ESD employees and children of ESD employees are ineligible.

Geographic Area: The scholarship must be used at a college or university located within the State of Michigan or one designated by the Gold Awardee, outside the state of Michigan. ***This year's scholarship is offered to an engineering student in a college or university within the state of Michigan.***

Academic Level and Major: **A.** At the start of the term for where the scholarship is sought, applicants must be attending full time and pursuing a course of study, leading to a career in a field designated by the Gold Awardee. ***This year's field of study is mechanical or architectural engineering.*** **B.** Applicants must be in or be going into their Junior or Senior undergraduate year or pursuing a Masters degree. **C.** Merit will be the primary interest of awarding the scholarship. An applicant should have at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale (or the equivalent of a "B").

Application (Only applications with all of the following required documents submitted will be reviewed.):

A. Filled-in application form. **B.** A paper of 400 to 500 words discussing your career interests and objectives. **C.** Two letters of recommendation; one by your academic advisor and one from a faculty member of the applicant's major. **D.** Official copies of applicant's college transcripts, both undergraduate and graduate, as applicable, sent directly by the applicant's school(s). **F.** Cover letter itemizing the enclosures.

Application documents must be sent by certified mail prior to January 15th, or hand delivered to the address specified at the bottom of this page. None of the materials will be returned.

Judging and Awards:

Judges: The entries will be judged by a panel representing the diverse membership of the Affiliate Council of The Engineering Society of Detroit. Judges will disqualify themselves from the judging panel if they are personally associated or related with an applicant. The decisions of the judges are final.

Award: The scholarship will be awarded at the Gold Awards Dinner for use in the current or following year. The Gold Awardee Scholarship recipient should attempt to attend the Gold Awards Dinner to accept their scholarship certificate, but attendance is not required. The amount of the scholarship will equal the amount raised. The check will be made out in the name of the student and will be administered by the university. The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees or such expenditures for academic purpose, as may be appropriate. An unsuccessful applicant may re-submit an application for another year, assuming the scholarship is continued.
